I downloaded the most current version of SMTube, extracted the lha file and placed the app folder in my Programs: dir. Upon execution of the software I get an error related to QT:

```
Failed to load shared object  
libQTWebKit.so
```

I tried locating this SO on OS4Depot, but no dice. I tried downloading the sources from:

But, I can't execute the command `svn co` because I don't have `svn` installed in the C:

I tried finding `svn` on OS4Depot, again, no luck finding it.

Another somewhat related question, when I `cd` to a directory containing the `AutoInstall` file, and I use `run AutoInstall`, the shell lets me know that the file is not executable. I also tried `AutoInstall`, for the SMTube installer file, via `sh AutoInstall` and results in the following error:

```
Ram:AutoInstall[1]: syntax error: `;' unexpected
```
