I did some more poking around and found out that there **are two official OS4 versions of Quake 2 from Hyperion.**

The first one is from 2005 and it only supports software rendering.

at the bottom of that page it reads

[5] In 2005, publisher Hyperion first released a native build of QUAKE II for AmigaOS 4.x. A substantially reworked AmigaOS 4.x update of QUAKE II, courtesy of Peter Gordon, was released in May 2010. Registered users of AmigaOS 4.x and QUAKE II may download it from their website [HERE](#).

I am a registered OS4 user with an account on Hyperion's website but I do not have access to that file.

Unfortunately it seems like it is a patch for the commercial 2002 WarpOS port. So you need to get ahold of the CD and register it to have access to the OS4 versions.

No idea where you can still buy that version of Quake 2.
