The problem I see with having multiple targets in each makefile is how to present that to the user without complicating the whole process.

CodeBench can currently create a makefile suitable for a target to be compiled with the compiler it targets (gcc in the case of the AmigaOS4SDK project type). In order to allow the user to specify different targets, the settings interface would need to be considerably changed, and would IMO complicate things for the beginner.

Advanced users are free to turn off the creation of build scripts and edit it as they see fit.

I'm currently talking about CodeBench as it exists now, I can't remember how much functionality is present in 0.8.

I would suggest holding back any future enhancement requests until 0.9 ships, then we can reassess what changes would be required, and at what cost. Ideally I'd like to keep the interface as simple as possible to make it easier for inexperienced programmers to start using the product. Seasoned hackers are free to use features more obscured :)
