OK, I haven't tested any of these devices extensively with AmigaOS4.1 Update 1, but they do all get recognized and I am able to access files on them. None of them worked at all before Update 1:

Canon EOS Rebel XS camera (DSLR)

Jazz HDV189 video camera

Dynex All-in-1 External Card Reader

Sylvania SMP2012 2GB MP3 player

A "Picture Transfer Protocol" window opens with thumbnails of all the pics on the Canon when it is plugged in, which I find really cool.

I have used the Dynex card reader to access files on a 4GB SDHC card, as well as on 512MB and 16MB CompactFlash cards. There is a problem when I format CompactFlash cards, though: A formatted card pops up a "Disk\_Warning!" window every time it is inserted, that says "Volume exceeds end of disk! Data loss may occur when writing!". The CompactFlash disks were formatted using FAT filesystem and maybe another filesystem would work OK.

I have some other USB devices that I haven't plugged in yet.
