I've never heard of Sylpheed, but I suspect it's using POP3 to download emails.

Gmail has a POP3 counter of some sort, which means POP3 clients only see emails once (this is probably also the reason why the "delete from server" function doesn't work as expected). If both Sylpheed and YAM are downloading emails, neither will be able to get the emails that the other has already downloaded.

The solution is to use IMAP for one of the clients. YAM doesn't support this of course, but maybe Sylpheed does?

I have many email clients here, except YAM they are all set to use IMAP and I don't have this problem.
