It's not terribly exciting, but with some clever Arexx-ing I think the use of third-party libraries might be useful. One could theoretically use some sort of [Java Google calendar library](#) and synn stuff with `limpidclock`, for instance. But that requires some amount of Java programming knowledge - but it isn't that hard.

I'm currently looking at enabling a [GIT versioning client](#), but that requires another native library which I haven't finished yet (as described [on the blog](#)).
