Quote:

I can't make a direct comparison to JosDuchIt's setup because I use a custom script to start AmiCygrix from a shell but a quick test of starting AmiCygrix and running AbiWord didn't cause any crashes. Since others have reported AmiCygrix working too, maybe JosDuchit needs a reinstall of AmiCygrix.

Yes, I think this could help.

Quote:

AmiCygrix is adding several environmental variables including a PATH variable. Other programs (Linux ports?) set the same variable to a different value. Check the topic "CMake progress" here on Amigans.net and you will see that people are being told to set a completely different PATH variable. I recommend changing all the AmiCygrix variables to something like "CYGPATH" or similar.

Since AmiCygrix 1.0 all programs are using environment variables stored in "ENVARC:Cygrix". The other variables including PATH are only set for the unix shell 'sh'. I know, this can be tricky.

BTW: The PATH variable is only set, if it does not exist before.

Quote:

If I run Snoopy after AmiCygrix has started and I open AbiWord I see this constantly repeated:  
lxpanel : o.k. = [exec] FindPort("XGeekTransPort.0") [2uS]  
openbox : o.k. = [exec] FindPort("XGeekTransPort.0") [2uS]  
Is that really necessary?

This occurs, when "quick transfer" is activated. Please launch "Cygrix:S/Utilities/Quick-Transfer-Off.bat" and it should disappear. This feature will be removed in future versions.
