My LDFLAGS look like this

```
-athread=native -WI,-no-keep-memory -L/sdk/local/newlib/lib
```

Now, do i need a double minus or a single minus after that -WI, (which, if i read that correctly, is some sort of grouping commands together)?

Could i add the -athread also to the -WI, part?

Where can i find a LD documentation that covers OUR version of LD (there is none in the SDK)?
