I extended C/C++ syntax file for richeditor (added newlib functions to the existing standard set) The original is nearly 6000 lines long admittedly but I built the extra bits with a trivial bit of perl and this was easy because of the simple structured nature of the data.

Don't be lazy it will save you effort in the long run and make your resource much more robust.
