Are you using a 'legacy parallel' PCI sound card?

I recall an thread about ethernet cards for the X5000 where someone said that the bottom two PCI slots don't support DMA transfers (can someone confirm this?) and that it was actually faster and less CPU intensive to use a PCI Express card even though it uses the exact same PCI chip connected to a PCI to PCI Express bridge.

There are PCI-E soundcards based on the CMI8738 if the Soundblaster Live! doesn't work out for you.
