The first argument of Assign needs to be the (virtual) volume name you want to use. So you can't make an assign that is more than a volume name (i.e. a name followed by a colon, no path after the colon).

You could try with MakeLink instead.

Something like:

```
makelink Sys:Utilities/Timi/GUS Work2:Programmi/Timidity/gus SOFT
```

It's possible that the filesystem you use (on SYS:) doesn't support softlinks, in which case it won't work.

Also, depending on the version of the makelink command, you may not actually need the SOFT keyword (as it may be default), but it won't harm.
