Sylpheed uses OpenSSL 0.98d. It's funny, that this outdated version works and the more current gnutls 2.12 not. I think gnutls uses a higher level TLS and old OpenSSL falls back to simple SSL - but I don't know exactly.

Looked again into the base package and into a test installation: The curl cert file is there! Maybe your archive is corrupt? Please check again for "curl-ca-bundle.crt" in "Cynix:CynixPPC/share/curl".

There is a TLS client included in the base package called "gnutls-cli". With this tool you can see what happens while creating your SSL/TLS connection and also send and receive data.

Open an amiga shell and type:

gnutls-cli hostname:995 (Maybe you have an other port number.)

There is also a second command for debugging:

gnutls-cli-debug hostname:995
