Thanks for your help.

I will give my first impressions.

At first I tested gcc10 and gcc09 without success.

Too many errors even with `-std=c++11 -mcrtd=...`

I managed to get my progs compiled with gcc09 with

`-std=c++11 -athread=native` (or something like that not sure of the syntax).

I compiled a hello prog and a more complex amiga program with suces.

I notice a problem though.

In one .cc file (located in `work:dir2` ) I declared an include like `#include "work:dir/file.h"`

I had an error during compilation

File not found `work:dir2/work:dir/file.h`

As you see, there is a bug here.

For the moment, I change the include by `/work/dir/file.h` in the linux way. I don't really like it.
