Too many errors even with `-std=c++11 -mcrtd=...`

I managed to get my progs compiled with gcc09 with

`-std=c++11 -athread=native` (or something like that not sure of the syntax).

You should always use `-athread=native`, if you want to compile anything with the latest GCC on OS4. At least for now, while it still not enabled by default.
