Be wary of your 2 GB RAM. Although it may seem to be fault-free, I would be very surprised if it did not have errors that are not detected in normal use, but only show up with large files in RAM.

So you might find that files that are copied into RAM and back to disk end up with corruptions.

Yes, I know that your RAM has "never shown a problem" etc, etc, but I don't believe that there are any A1s that work faultlessly with 2 DIMMs in place. I can always be proved wrong, of course, and PowerAmiga will argue, but don't trust it.

Hmm. I never said that my RAM have no pb or bla-bla of this type. I do not know if the 2 modules are fault-free, or not as memtester reports inconsistent results according to the slot(s) or the RAM module(s) used. But in real use (testing OS4 final atm), I did not notice troubles. Soon I will test these modules in an old PC to see if they are really fault-free or not.

Is that ok for you?
