So, to sum up. Can anybody confirm if I am correct.

In SFS 1.274 there are really two types of SFS: SFS/0 and SFS/2. Purpose of this is just to separate things for large files (for those below 4 GB the system uses SFS/0, for those above - SFS/2).

SFS/0 has the limit for the size of the file to 4 GB while SFS/2 can break the boundary of 4 GB.
