One of the things VS has in its favour is that it is designed to be used for one purpose, CodeBench is designed to be as general as possible to accommodate any language. While certain language specific stuff can be implemented by the plugins, the complexity is limited by the fact that it is just a plugin, and cannot replace all IDE functionality.

Things like variable definition tracking etc are beyond the scope of this application, and are the job of the preprocessor. In order to implement what you mention would mean practically writing my own preprocessor. Sadly, that is not going to happen.

I'm adding features all the time, and in its current state it is more than usable. My goal is to add the last remaining couple of things, then freeze the development. Concentrate on fixing outstanding issues, and get it releasable.
