Alright, let's try this:

- Open Locale and change to the 'Country' tab.
- Scroll down to 'Thailand'
- On my system, the column 'Local name' shows squares instead of thai characters. What about yours?

You need to have a TTF font installed which contains those characters. I "borrowed" a copy of the Arial Unicode MS font from my wife's old Windows PC (she is not using the old one any more, so I guess it's not a breach of copyright). There is also a freely available font out there which should do the trick, I don't recall the name, but it is mentioned in OWB's documentation. Remember to use Typemanager to install it properly, and then activate the following tooltype in the Prefs/Locale icon:

```
FONTNAME="Arial Unicode MS"
```

(or corresponding if you use the other font).
