Plus, VBCC doesn't have C++ support, and that's going to matter further down the track when you want to do Object Orientated Programming (OOP). OOP makes working on larger projects much easier.

Just so you know, if you intend to learn C++ then it's not recommended or considered an advantage to learn 'plain' C or any other low level programming for that matter before learning C++ as it's too much of a different language than C for that.
