I have added a "PictureView" entry in my contextualMenu who calls FastView with 2 arguments, "SinglePicture" and the file name.

If the file is a picture,

it opens it in a screen scaled window (like the single click in FastView)

If you press space bar, it swap between screen-scaled and real-size picture.

If you double-click, press enter, escape or click on close gadget, it quit the program.

I have too kept the "set wallpaper", "open drawer" and "delete picture" menu options.

Of course, multiples instances of the program are allowed.

It was something like that ?

But I have a question, Phantom suggested me to use FastView like MultiView in the deficon.

I don't know how to insert an argument in a .info file for a CLI program.

What I would like to do is when I click on a JPG.info file, it calls

"FastView SinglePicture file_name.jpg"

It works only when I insert "SinglePicture" in the "Specify parameters" requester.
