I meant that in standard mode (with main FastView window) by default the rotation occurs NOT on the original picture but on a new picture .ROTATE.

Except if you use ROTATE\_INPLACE Tooltype (it was the default on first version)

In SinglePicture mode it will be a pain (for me of course) to implement that.

And remember that rotation is not disruptive for your picture, if you make a mistake, you just have to rotate in other direction...
